

MYRTLEFORD SHOW HORSE SCHEDULE – 25 October 2008

Rules & Regulations

Entry Fees: \$2.50 per class for all Rings

- Exhibitors must complete an insurance declaration form before competing.
- No event will be held for exhibitors competing in another ring.
- Rosettes will be awarded for 1st place, ribbons for 2nd & 3rd places in all Rings. Ribbons only in Stockhorse events.
- A horse, galloway or pony may only win one open championship under saddle, there is no restriction on first placing or reserve championships.
- **A “First Season” hack, Galloway or pony is not to have competed undersaddle prior to the 1st January 2006.**
- Stallions must be exhibited in led & ridden classes by person's 18 years & over.
- Pony Club uniform is acceptable for all events at this show.
- Exhibitor's age is taken as on the day of this show.
- A novice horse or pony has not won a first prize at an agricultural show.
- Local exhibitors must reside in the Alpine Shire or within a 30km radius of Myrtleford.
- Any rider under the age of 18 years, riding a horse at an EFA or affiliated event, must wear protective head gear to the current Australian standard. The retaining harness must be secured & fastened at all times. Riders without approved head gear shall be ineligible to compete until rectified. This rule applies to all events, not just age competitions.
