**Tenders open on 1 May, and must be lodged no later than 5 pm on 30 July 2009**

Information and Pictures of the Stallions available will soon be on our Website for you to view. Those without internet access can request this to be mailed to you.

This will be our major fundraiser for the year, with all proceeds of the tender being donated, by the stallion owners, directly to our group, to use for show sponsorship.

**Please Note that the minimum bid is \$350 and a \$50 handling fee per stallion**

Please remember, some of these Stallions DO NOT stand at public stud, so use this opportunity to send one of your mares to one of these highly regarded Stallions,

for a much reduced Stud fee. GOOD LUCK to everyone!!!!

## HOW TO ENTER

**Tenders must be lodged no later than 5 pm on 30 July 2009.** Submit your tender by nominating an amount in the Tender Column for one or as many stallions as you like. Do not send money now – if you are successful you will be notified shortly after close of the tender and an invoice will be sent to you for payment.

All tenders remain confidential.

## Conditions of Tender

1. Acceptance of any tender will be subject to these conditions of tender and any additional conditions specified by the Stallion Owner.
2. Minimum tender bid of \$350 applies. In addition, a \$50.00 handling fee applies to all Stallions.
3. Tenders open on 1 May, and must be lodged no later than 5 pm on 30 July 2009.
4. In the event that two tenders for the same amount are received for the same stallion, the tender which was lodged on the earlier date shall be the preferred tender.
5. Successful tenderers will be notified within 14 days of the closing date.
6. Service to be used during the 2009 breeding season.
7. Acceptance of any tender shall be at the sole discretion of Small Shetland Ponies 8.2hh & Under APSB Promotional Group.
8. In the event of your tender being accepted payment must be made to Small Shetland Ponies 8.2hh & Under APSB Promotional Group in full by 31st July 2009. Please note, that by submitting a tender, you make yourself liable to pay that amount should your bid be successful.
9. On receipt of payment Small Shetland Ponies 8.2hh & Under APSB Promotional Group will advise the Stallion Owner of the successful bidder.
10. Where Live Foal Guarantee applies - if the mare shall abort or if the foal shall not stand and nurse, the mare owner may return the mare for the 2010 breeding season only without payment of a service fee provided that the mare owner provides the stallion owner with a certificate from a veterinary surgeon confirming that the mare aborted following a 45 day positive test in foal or that the foal did not stand and nurse.

11. Where Free Return applies – if the mare shall abort the mare owner may return the mare for the 2010 breeding season only without payment of a service fee provided that the mare owner provides the stallion owner with a certificate from a veterinary surgeon confirming that the mare aborted following a 45 day positive test in foal.
12. A handling fee will apply if a mare returns in the 2010 season on any Stallion that offers a Live Foal Guarantee or Free Return.
13. It is the responsibility of the mare owner to confirm that the mare is free from contagious disease and is in normal breeding condition.
14. The Stallion Owner and Small Shetland Ponies 8.2hh & Under APSB Promotional Group accepts no responsibility for any accident, death or injury to the mare whilst on the Stallion Owner's property.
15. The mare may not be released from the Stallion Owner's property until all outstanding agistment and vet costs have been paid in full.
16. The mare owner agrees to pay agistment accounts within 30 days of receipt and prior to collection from the Stallion Owner's property.
17. The mare owner agrees to pay all veterinary accounts related to the mare direct to the veterinary surgery that has rendered an account for the treatment of the mare.
18. The mare owner agrees to abide by any delivery conditions imposed by the Stallion Owner.
19. Should the stallion die or become unfit for service, this agreement shall become invalid and Small Shetland Ponies 8.2hh & Under APSB Promotional Group shall refund the full tender price.
20. All Mares to be sent to Stallions must be registered with the A.P.S.B.S, and must be under 8.2hh, **no over height Mares will be excepted.**
21. In lodging a tender you agree to and accept the conditions of tender and any conditions imposed by the Stallion Owner.
